



الكلمات الدالة عن الماضي البسيط هي

yesterday / last / ago / past / that time / in ancient / before + وقت ex; before 3 hours , before 2020 etc.

Examples:

- 1) Mohammed borrowed my notebook yesterday. (borrow)
- Ahmed retired last year. (retire)
- 3) My family went to the garden ten minutes ago. (go)
- 4) We didn't save the file in the past. (not. save)
- The boys didn't play football yesterday. (not. play)
- 6) Did the girls clean the kitchen before an hour? (clean)
- 7) Sara was in France in 1990. (be) was للمفرد were
- 8) Assad didn't was with Ahmed last night. (not. be)





He drinks coffee at 7:30 AM everyday.



Present Simple



No, I don't.




Do you drive to work?

Present Simple uses the auxiliary verb <u>do</u> in questions and negatives

No, I <u>don't</u>. I walk.

I do walk.



Do you drive to work?

Present Simple uses the auxiliary verb <u>do</u> in questions and negatives but not in the affirmative (positive statement).



Are you enjoying your new book?

Present Continuous uses the auxiliary verb to be in questions



Are you enjoying your new book?

Lisa is working at a bookstore.

Present Continuous uses the auxiliary verb <u>to be</u> in questions, affirmative (positive statements)




Are you enjoying your new book?

Lisa <u>is</u> working at a bookstore. She <u>isn't</u> working at the library.


Present Continuous uses the auxiliary verb <u>to be</u> in affirmative, questions, and negatives.

He used a computer this morning.



Past tense

I went to Japan last year.




a past action that is now finished

Past Simple


عمل سابق انتهى الآن

Past Simple uses the auxiliary verb <u>did</u> in questions


<u>Did</u> you work last year?



No, I didn't.

Past Simple uses the auxiliary verb <u>did</u> in questions and negatives

I went to school.




I did went to school.
